CLASSES AND LEVELING

Class Leveling

At Doll Girls Dance, class placement is determined solely at the discretion of our dance teachers and studio owner. Each dancer is evaluated on their individual technique, maturity, focus, and readiness to ensure they are placed in the level that best supports their growth.

Our goal is to make sure every dancer receives the appropriate challenge, individualized attention, and technical foundation they need to thrive. Because dancers progress at different rates, leveling is not based on age alone. Teachers may adjust a dancer's placement at any time to ensure they are in the environment where they will be most successful.

Proper leveling helps dancers:

- Build strong technique without developing unsafe habits
- Gain confidence by mastering skills step-by-step
- Stay motivated with appropriate challenges
- Progress safely and steadily
- Feel supported in a class that matches their pace

If a dancer is ready for a new challenge or needs more time in a foundational level, teachers may adjust placement at any point in the season.

Recreational Program Overview

At DGD, we offer a well-rounded recreational dance program designed to build confidence, discipline, strong technique, and a lifelong love for dance. Our classes provide high-quality training without the commitment of competition teams, making them perfect for dancers who want to grow, learn, and have fun. Below is an overview of the classes we offer.

Ballet & Jazz Combo

A required technique block that builds strong, well-rounded dancers. Ballet develops posture, alignment, strength, and control, while Jazz adds sharp lines, dynamic movement, and performance quality. Together, this combo creates the foundation dancers need for all other styles.

Lyrical

A style that blends ballet and jazz technique with expressive, emotional movement. Dancers learn to tell a story through fluid choreography, musicality, and control.

Hip Hop

A high-energy class focused on rhythm, grooves, and confidence. Dancers explore age-appropriate hip hop foundations, musicality, and performance style.

Tap

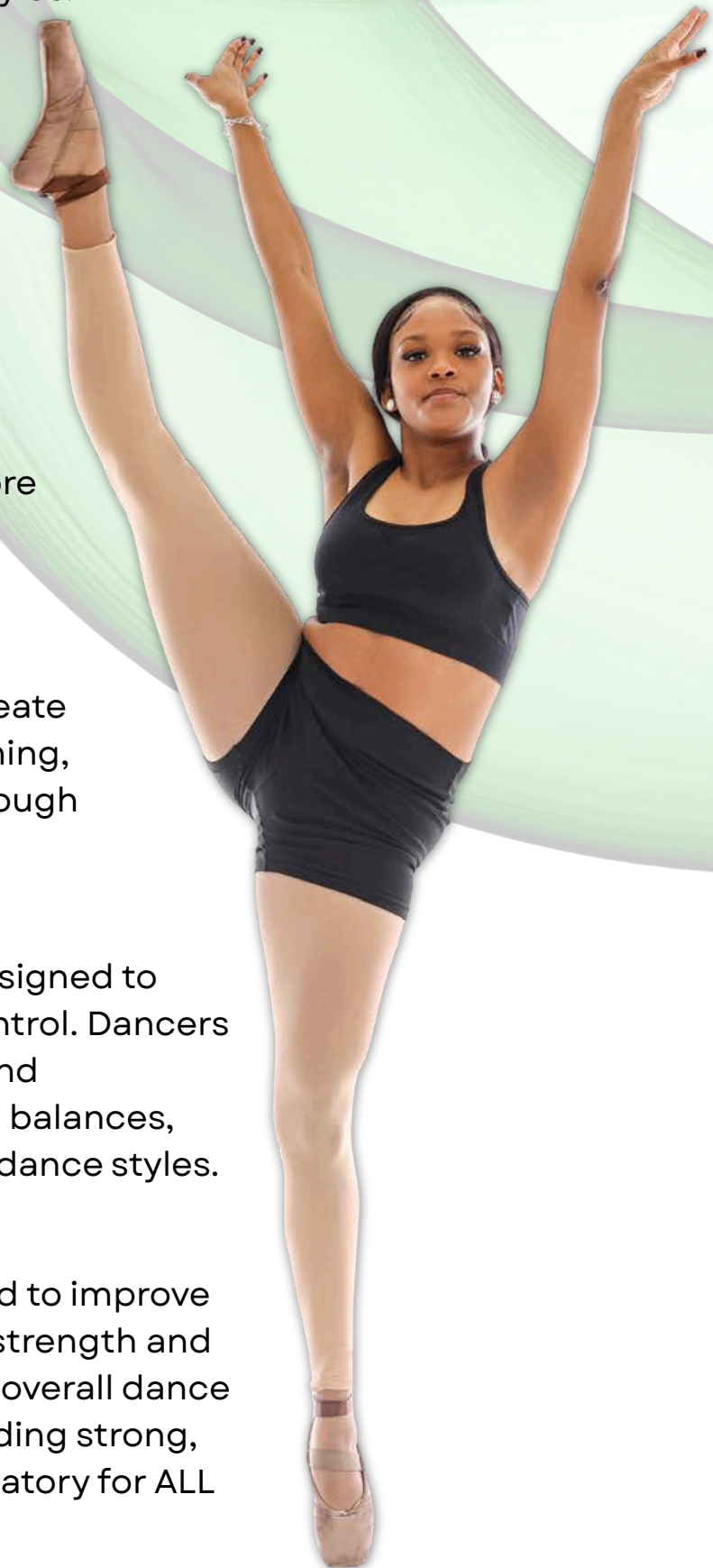
A rhythm-based class where dancers create sound with their feet. Students build timing, coordination, and musical precision through progressive tap technique.

Flexibility & Acro

A combined strength-and-skills class designed to improve mobility, balance, and body control. Dancers work on safe stretching, conditioning, and foundational acro skills such as bridges, balances, and smooth transitions that support all dance styles.

Elevate Technique

A comprehensive training class designed to improve ballet technique, barre work, flexibility, strength and conditioning, balance, leaps, turns, and overall dance performance. This class focuses on building strong, technical, and confident dancers. Mandatory for ALL elite team members.

STUDIO POLICIES

Dress Code

To ensure a focused and productive learning environment, please make sure your dancer arrives to class dressed appropriately:

All dance shoes must be brought in a labeled bag and should not be worn outside to preserve the studio floors.

Standard black attire is required for all classes.

- Tops: Leotards or sports bras in black.
- Tights: Tights must be worn when wearing shorts. Only wearing black shorts or leggings, skin-tone tights must be worn underneath.
- DGD shirts are permitted in Hip Hop classes only.
- Absolutely no Crocs, Hey Dudes, or slippers are allowed in Hip Hop or any other class.
- Proper dance attire, secure hair (in a net if wearing beads), and no jewelry are required for every class.
- Basic hygiene is expected: Keep deodorant in your dance bag to reapply as needed.
- Jeans are not permitted in any dance class, including hip hop.
- Dance shoes are for studio use only. Do not wear dance shoes outside. Change from street shoes into labeled, class-specific dance shoes upon arrival.

Dancers not in proper attire may be asked to sit out of class.

Attendance & Punctuality

- Students must arrive 5-10 minutes before class to allow time to use the restroom, change, remove jewelry, and secure hair neatly.
- Students must be READY TO DANCE at the start of class.
- Students who miss three or more classes may receive a reduced role in upcoming performances.

Personal Belongings

- Students and parents are responsible for their own items. Please label all personal belongings.
- Do not bring valuables to the studio. DGD is not responsible for lost, stolen, or misplaced property.

STUDIO POLICIES

Tuition Auto-Draft Policy

Tuition will be drafted on the 3rd of each month using the card or banking information on file.

If the draft is unsuccessful, the following fees will apply:

- \$15 return fee
- \$25 late fee

If payment is not received by the 10th, your dancer will not be permitted to attend class until the full balance is paid.

Families are responsible for keeping their payment information updated in the system at all times.

Cash payments must be received **before the 1st** of the month.

Student Behavior Policy

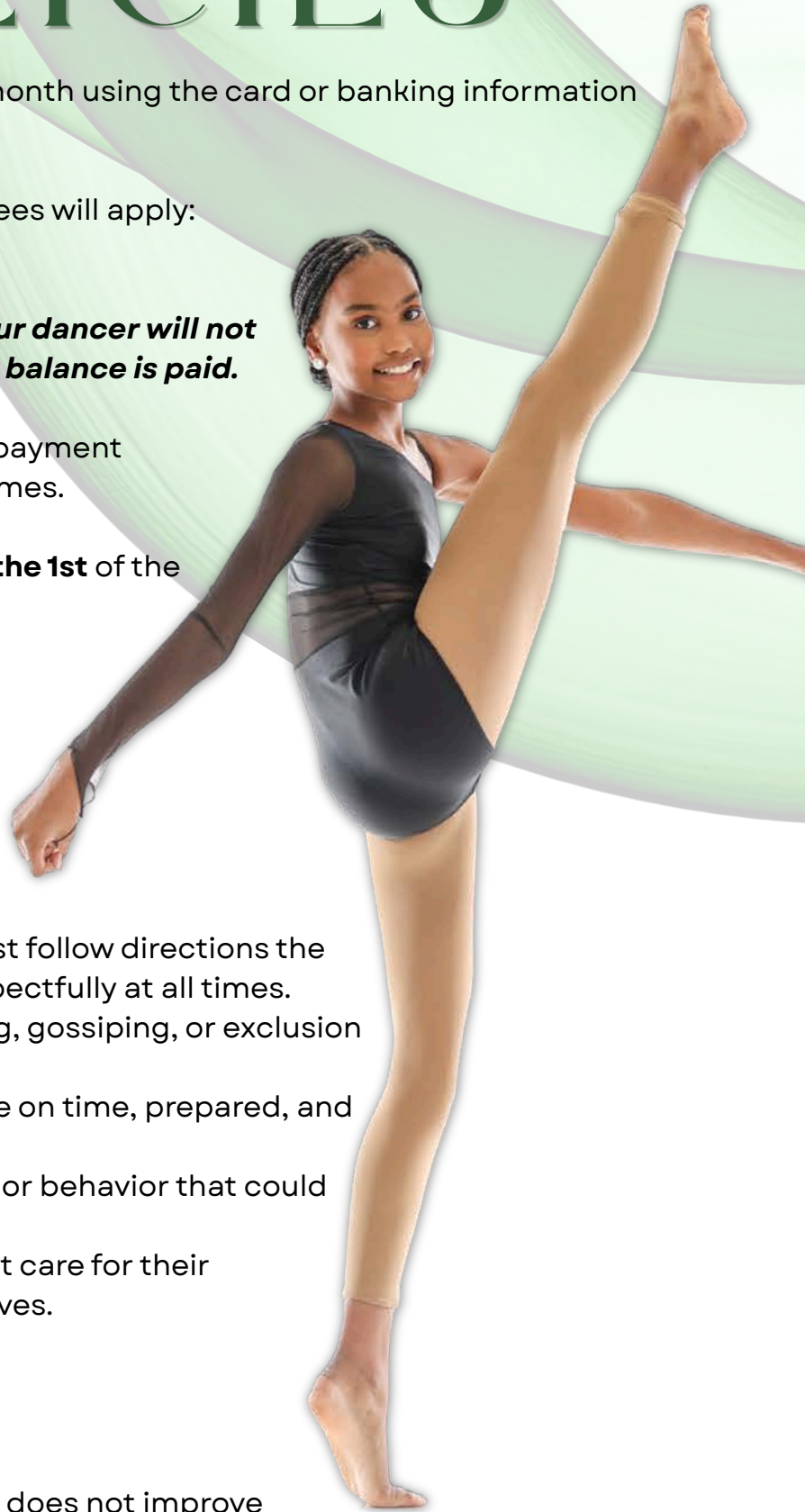
Students of Doll Girls Dance Studio are expected to uphold the highest standards of conduct. These expectations ensure a safe, respectful, and productive learning environment.

Expectations

- Respect for instructors – Students must follow directions the first time they are given and speak respectfully at all times.
- Respect for peers – No teasing, bullying, gossiping, or exclusion of any kind.
- Studio etiquette – Students must arrive on time, prepared, and in proper attire.
- Safe behavior – No running, horseplay, or behavior that could cause injury.
- Personal responsibility – Students must care for their belongings and clean up after themselves.

Consequences

- Verbal warning
- Parent notification
- Temporary removal from class
- Dismissal from the program if behavior does not improve



STUDIO POLICIES

Parent Behavior Policy

Parents and guardians play a vital role in maintaining a positive studio environment. The following expectations apply to all adults associated with Doll Girls Dance Studio.

Expectations

- Respectful communication – Speak to staff, instructors, and other families with courtesy at all times.
- Supportive environment – Encourage your dancer and avoid negative comments about other students or instructors.
- Lobby conduct – Keep noise to a minimum and supervise siblings at all times.
- No interference – Parents may not enter classrooms or interrupt instruction unless invited by staff.
- Timely pickup – Dancers must be picked up promptly at the end of class.

Violations may result in:

- Written warning
- Meeting with the studio owner
- Removal from the studio if behavior does not improve

Right to Refuse Service

Doll Girls Dance Studio reserves the right to refuse service or discontinue enrollment to any student or family who:

- Fails to comply with studio policies
- Exhibits behavior that is disruptive, unsafe, or disrespectful
- Creates a hostile environment for staff, students, or other families
- Repeatedly fails to meet financial obligations

This policy is in place to protect the safety, well-being, and integrity of the studio community.

Media & Photography Policy

Doll Girls Dance Studio may photograph or record classes, rehearsals, and performances for promotional use. By enrolling, families grant permission for the studio to use images or videos of their dancer for studio marketing, unless a written opt-out is submitted.

Parents may not take photos or videos inside classrooms without staff approval to protect student privacy.

STUDIO POLICIES

Drop-Off & Pick-Up Policy

To ensure dancer safety:

- Students must remain inside the studio until a parent or guardian arrives.
- Parents must pick up dancers promptly at the end of class.
- The studio is not responsible for supervision outside of class times.
- Repeated late pickups may result in additional fees or removal from the program.

If you are more than 15 minutes late for pick-up, a \$10 late fee will be added to your account.

Health & Safety Policy

To maintain a clean and safe environment:

- Dancers showing symptoms of illness must stay home.
- Any injuries must be reported immediately to staff.
- Students must follow all studio safety rules, including proper warm-up and no horseplay.
- The studio reserves the right to send a dancer home if they appear ill.

Performance & Rehearsal Policy

Performances are a privilege and require commitment.

- Mandatory rehearsals must be attended to participate in shows.
- Costumes must be paid in full before distribution.
- Students must follow all backstage rules during performances.

Communication Policy

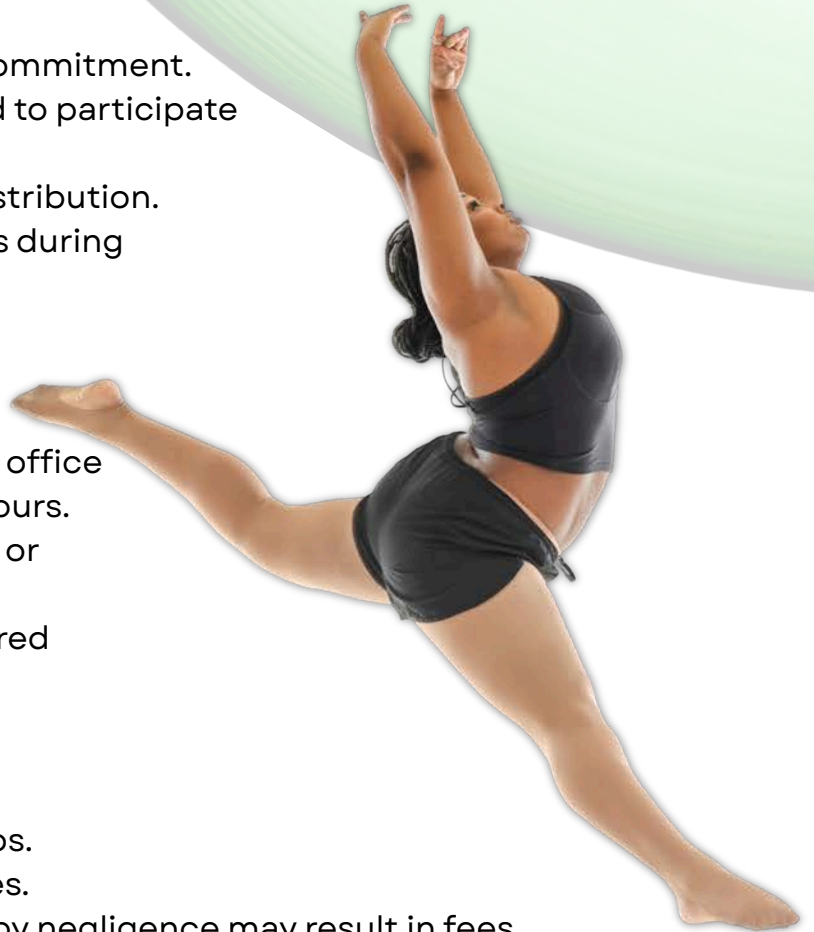
To maintain professionalism:

- All communication must go through the office manager, not instructors during class hours.
- Parents should use email, written notes, or scheduled meetings for concerns.
- Social media messages are not considered official communication.

Studio Property & Facility Policy

Respect for the space is required.

- No food or drink (except water) in studios.
- Students must clean up after themselves.
- Any damage to studio property caused by negligence may result in fees.

Zero-Tolerance Policy

The studio maintains a zero-tolerance stance on:

- Bullying
- Harassment
- Violence
- Discrimination
- Threatening behavior

Violations may result in immediate dismissal.

By continuing enrollment at Doll Girls Dance Studio, all dancers and families agree to follow the policies outlined in this handbook. These expectations ensure fairness, safety, and professionalism for every member of our studio.

Failure to comply with these policies may result in disciplinary action, suspension, or removal from the program at the discretion of the studio owner. Our priority is to maintain a positive, productive environment where dancers can thrive.
